## The basics

- All pesticides in Canada must meet the requirements of the Pest Control Products Act (PCPA) and its regulations.
- Health Canada's PMRA consults with the public on all proposed major registration decisions, including **new** registrations, major **new uses** of a pesticide, re-evaluation and special reviews
- Re-evaluation of pesticides happens cyclically every 15 years
- Special reviews may be initiated at any time
- Special reviews differ from re-evaluation in that special reviews are intended to examine only specific aspects of a pcp



# PMRA Re-evaluation and Special Review Work Plan 2022-2027 (REV2022-01)

- Each spring, the PMRA publishes an updated Re-evaluation and Special Review Work Plan.
- Includes all ongoing re-evaluations and special reviews as well as new reevaluations expected to be initiated in this time frame

• This 5-year work plan may change in response to work load and to emerging issues that require priority action

## **Basis for Re-evaluation**

- To ensure older pesticides that no longer meet modern standards are removed from the Canadian market and the use instructions on product labels are updated to best protect:
  - users,
  - bystanders,
  - environment
- Under current legislation, all pesticides will be reevaluated on a 15-year cycle.

# **Policy on Cancellation/Amendments**

- Regulatory Proposal PRO2016-04 Management of Pesticide Re-evaluation
   Policy
- Phase-out timeline for cancellation of pesticides that don't meet modern standards for health &/ or environmental protection:

_	Last date of sale by registrant	1 year
_	Last date of sale by retail	1 year
_	Last date of permitted use	1 year

- Users usually have up to 3 years following the re-evaluation decision to cancel
- Up to **2 years** for amendments (label changes)

## Potassium Chloride & Potash Molluscide

- RD2022-07 (30 June 2022)
- For control of zebra & quagga mussels in water reservoirs and other water bodies as well as water in pipelines and closed systems, including fire suppression systems in hydroelectric plants
- Under approved conditions of use, the health and environmental risks and the value of the pcps are acceptable

- At the time PRD2020-17 was published (18 December 2020), Imazapyr was registered for control of weeds to non-cropland sites and in imazapyr tolerant canola and lentil crops
